Almond Joy Culture

Taboo: Never use your left arm or left hand Greeting: Cross the arms nod and say 'Ah-Hah'

Attitude towards <u>your</u> culture: You are very arrogant and overly proud of your culture. Your culture is the best. Everything you do is amazing. You are very concerned with status, occupation, and how much money you make.

You are offended easily, especially when people ask you about your occupation. That does not define you! Attitude towards <u>other</u> cultures: You are completely unaccepting of other cultures. You are judgmental and mean. When talking: Speak Loudly

Hersey Culture

Taboo: never touch others and don't let others touch you

Greeting: double wink and say 'Hey-Hey-Hey'

Attitude towards <u>your</u> culture: You live in a culture that honors traditional occupations like farming. You are very negative about everything!

Attitude towards <u>other</u> cultures: You find other cultures funny and strange. You are a little uncomfortable by things that are different than you.

When talking: always keep a good distance away (more than an arm's length)
