FRQ Task Verbs:

Compare: Provide a description or explanation of similarities and/or differences.

- Define: Provide a specific meaning for a word or concept.
- Describe: Provide the relevant characteristics of a specified topic.
- Explain: Provide information about how or why a relationship, process, pattern, position, or outcome

occurs, using evidence and/or reasoning.

• <u>Identify</u>: Indicate or provide information about a specified topic, without elaboration or explanation.

ACE the FRQs:



A. Define the term "refugee"


a. A person who flees, is displaced, or is forced to leave his or her home country.


- B. Describe ONE positive effects for countries that receive migrants.


